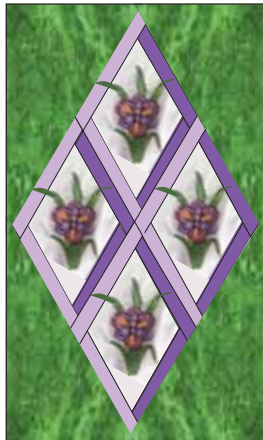


Quilting the Kaye Wood Way

with embroidery, applique & patchwork

Stained Glass Diamonds Wallhanging



23" x 38"

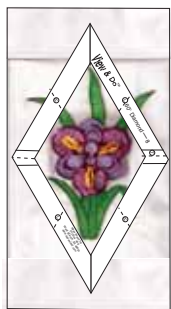

Embroider the designs:

Cut four pieces of background fabric 10" x 17".

Center the background fabric in an embroidery hoop.

Embroider and applique the designs on all four pieces of background fabric, following the directions on the disk.



Center each embroidered and appliqued design inside the opening of the 8" Diamond Shape.

The design of the fabric should line up vertically (up and down) with the solid lines at the top and bottom of the Diamond Shape.

Rotary cut around the outside of the 8" Diamond Shape.



Diamond Borders.

Cut the border strips:

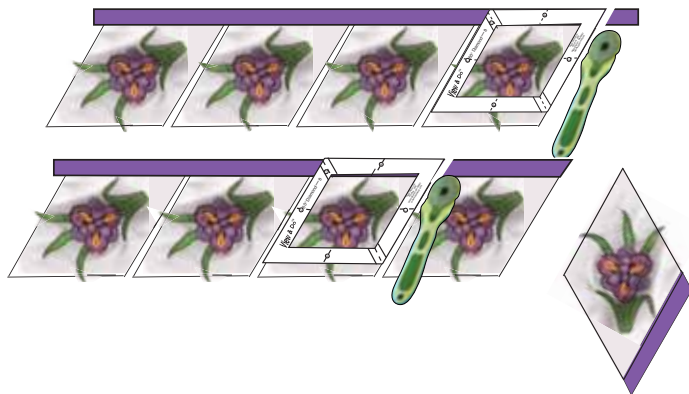
Cut 3 1/2" x 42" strips of the dark fabric.

Cut 4 1/2" x 42" strips of the light fabric.

Chain stitch a dark strip to the bottom right side of each of the diamonds.

Press the seam allowances toward the strip and away from the diamond.

Cut the strip between each of the diamonds by lining up the View & Do™ Diamond Shape with the strip and the side of the fabric diamond.

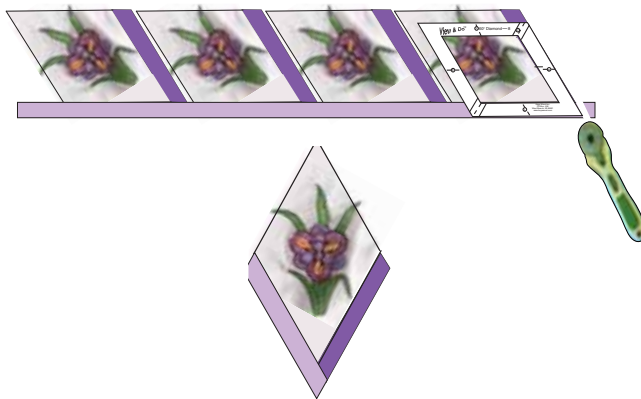

Sew a light strip to the bottom right side of each of the diamonds.

Press the seam allowances toward the strip and away from the diamond.

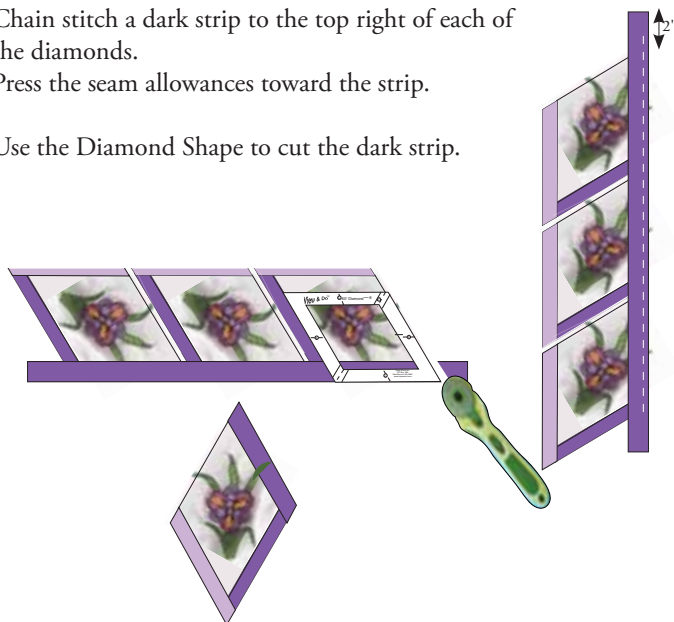
Cut the strip between each of the diamonds by lining up the View & Do™ Diamond Shape with the strip and the side of the fabric diamond.



Chain stitch a dark strip to the top right of each of the diamonds.

Press the seam allowances toward the strip.

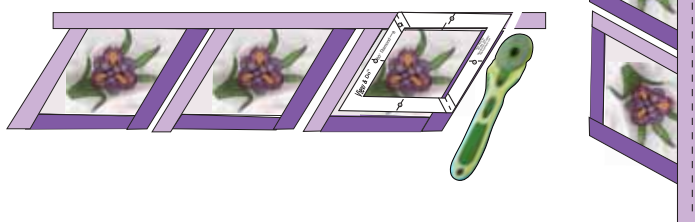
Use the Diamond Shape to cut the dark strip.



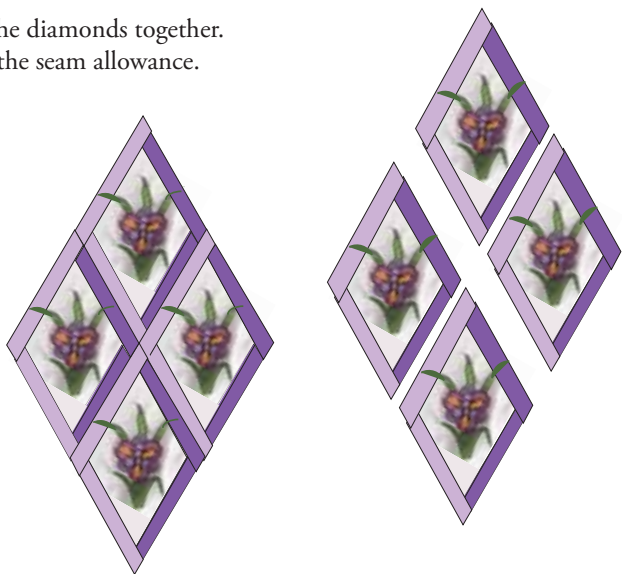
Chain stitch a light strip to the top left of each of the diamonds.

Cut the strip between each of the diamonds by lining up the View & Do™ Diamond Shape with the strip and the side of the fabric diamond.

Sew the diamonds together.



Sew the diamonds together.
Press the seam allowance.



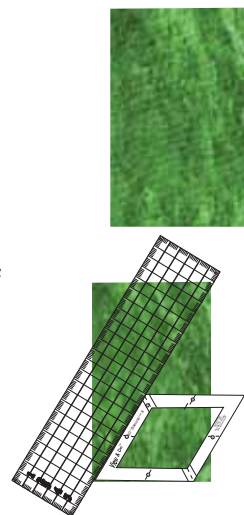
Square up the corners with triangles.

Cut two pieces of fabric 12" x 21".

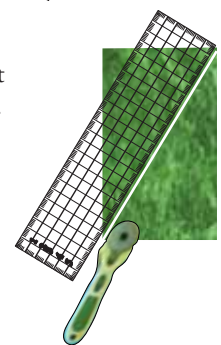
Place the two fabrics, right sides together.

Line up the Diamond Shape even with the bottom of the two pieces of fabrics to insure the accurate angle.

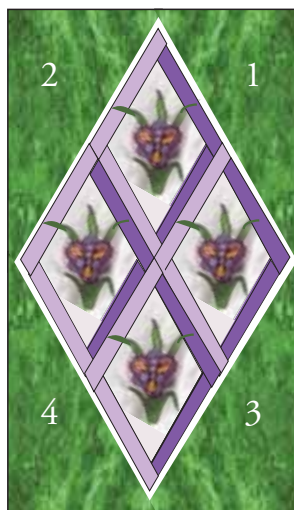
Place a ruler next to the View & Do™ Diamond Shape.



Remove the Diamond Shape and rotary cut along the two pieces diagonally from lower left to upper right to get the four triangles needed.



Sew the four triangles around the center diamond.
